The Mafia (also known as *Cosa Nostra*, in English "Our Thing") is a <u>criminal syndicate</u> in <u>Sicily</u>, <u>Italy</u>. It is a loose association of criminal groups that share a common organizational structure and code of conduct, and whose common enterprise is to protect businesses through violence outside the sanction of the law. Criminals provide protection to persons and properties in exchange of a future favor. Each group, known as a "family", "clan", or "*cosca*", claims <u>sovereignty</u> over a territory, usually a town or village or a neighborhood (*borgata*) of a larger city, in which it operates. Its members call themselves "men of honor", although the public often refers to them as "Mafiosi".

According to the classic definition, the Mafia is a criminal organization originating in Sicily. However, the term "mafia" has become a generic term for any organized criminal network with similar structure, methods, and interests.
