
a) What do you know about boxing?

Rules of Boxing

- · You cannot hit below the belt.
- You cannot hit with your head, shoulder, forearm, or elbow.
- You cannot hit with an open glove, the inside of the glove, the wrist, the backhand, or the side of the hand.
- You cannot punch your opponent's back, or the back of his head or neck, or on the kidneys.
- If you score a knockdown of your opponent, you must go to the farthest neutral corner while the referee makes the count.
- If you "floor" your opponent, you cannot hit him.
- A floored boxer has up to ten seconds to get back up on his feet before losing by knockout.
- A boxer who is knocked down cannot be saved by the bell in any round, depending upon the local jurisdiction's rules. http://boxrec.com/media/index.php/Rules of Boxing
