An **illusion** is a <u>distortion</u> of the senses, revealing how the brain normally organizes and interprets sensory stimulation. Though illusions distort reality, they are generally <u>shared</u> by most people. Illusions may occur with any of the human senses, but visual illusions (optical illusions), are the most well-known and understood. The emphasis on visual illusions occurs because vision often dominates the other senses. For example, individuals

watching a ventriloquist will perceive that the voice is coming from the dummy since they are able to see the words in the dummy's mouth.

Some illusions are based on general assumptions the brain makes during perception. Other illusions occur because of biological sensory structures within the human body or conditions outside of the body within one's physical environment.

The term *illusion* refers to a specific form of sensory distortion; an illusion describes a <u>misinterpretation</u> of a true sensation.

Magic is a performing art that entertains audiences by staging tricks or creating illusions of seemingly impossible or supernatural <u>feats</u> using natural means. These feats are called *magic tricks, effects,* or *illusions*.

A professional who performs such illusions is called a *magician* or an *illusionist*. Some performers may also be referred to by names reflecting the type of magical effects they present, such as *prestidigitators*, *conjurors*, *hypnotists*, *mentalists*, or *escape artists*.


